Code of Ethics for Board Members

- Board members shall abide by the FLGISA Member Code of Ethics and Standards of Conduct.
- Board members will conduct the business affairs of the association in good faith and with honesty, integrity, due diligence, and competence.
- Board members shall exercise proper authority and good judgment in their dealings with association staff, exhibitors and the general public and will respond to the needs of the members in a responsible, respectful and professional manner.
- No Board member will misuse association property or resources and will at all times keep the association's property secure and not allow any person not authorized by the Board to have or use such property.
- Board members will use their best efforts to regularly participate in all activities of the association.
- Board members shall dedicate themselves to leading by example in service the needs of the association and its members and also in representing the interest and ideals of local government technology professionals.
- Board members shall at all times act in the best interests of the association and not for personal or third party gain or financial enrichment. When encountering potential conflicts of interest, Board members will identify the conflict and, as required, remove themselves from all discussion and voting on the matter.
- Board members shall not promote any third party interest on behalf of the FLGISA beyond that which the Board has approved for all vendors participating with the association.
- Board members and their immediate families may not accept bribes, gifts, kickbacks or any other improper payments for services relating to their conduct as a Board member.
